Preparations for NextGen for CJA Attorneys

CJA Panel Members:

On August 2, 2021, the U.S. District Court for the District of Colorado will be upgrading its Case Management/Electronic Case Filing System (CM/ECF) to the Next Generation of CM/ECF (NextGen). CJA attorneys will only need one <u>individual</u> upgraded PACER account to file in the District starting August 2, 2021. In order to prepare for NextGen, you must upgrade your <u>individual/non-exempt</u> PACER account. You will no longer need your exempt PACER account, the login for which is preceded by "x=", to file in this District starting August 2nd, as you will be able to toggle between exempt and non-exempt status within the NextGen CM/ECF system itself.

Follow the instructions attached to this email or visit <u>CM/ECF NextGen | US District Court of</u> <u>Colorado (uscourts.gov)</u> to upgrade your individual/non-exempt PACER account <u>now</u>. If you wait until on or after August 2nd, you will have to follow a different set of instructions which will be sent at a later time.
