ORDER DENYING APPLICATION FOR REINSTATEMENT  
TO THE BAR OF THE COURT

---

Before the Disciplinary Panel is the application of Robert E. Abrams, petitioning the Court under D.C.COLO.LAttyR 11 for reinstatement to the bar. In correspondence dated November 22, 2025, the Committee on Conduct submitted to the Court a unanimous recommendation of the Committee that the Disciplinary Panel deny Mr. Abrams' petition for reinstatement. Having reviewed the Committee's recommendation letter and other pertinent documentary evidence on file, the Disciplinary Panel concurs with the Committee's recommendation. The Disciplinary Panel agrees with the Committee that, in light of the repeated disciplinary violations as set forth in the Committee's recommendation and exhibits submitted therewith, Mr. Abrams has failed to satisfy the requirements for reinstatement under D.C.COLO.LAttyR 11 by failing to establish clear and convincing evidence of his rehabilitation and fitness to practice law.

It is therefore ORDERED that the application submitted by Robert E. Abrams pursuant to D.C.COLO.LAttyR 11 and seeking to be reinstated to the practice of law before the United States District Court for the District of Colorado is hereby DENIED.
