ORDER DENYING PETITION FOR RELIEF FROM THE
RULE OF GOOD STANDING


Before the Disciplinary Panel is the petition of Allan I. Kroll seeking relief from the rule of good standing pursuant to D.C.COLO.LAttyR 3(d). In correspondence provided in December 2025, the Committee on Conduct submitted to the Court a unanimous recommendation of the Committee that the Disciplinary Panel deny Mr. Kroll's petition. Having reviewed the Committee's recommendation letter and other pertinent documentary evidence on file, the Disciplinary Panel concurs with the Committee's recommendation. The Disciplinary Panel agrees with the Committee that Mr. Kroll has failed to establish, by clear and convincing evidence, that the application of the rule of good standing to Mr. Kroll will result in a grave injustice.

It is therefore ORDERED that the petition submitted by Allan I. Kroll seeking relief from the rule of good standing is hereby DENIED.
