ORDER DENYING RELIEF FROM THE RULE OF GOOD STANDING

Before the Disciplinary Panel is the "Application for Relief from the Rule of Good Standing, Pursuant to D.C.COLO.LAttyR 3(d)(1)" filed by Petitioner, Joseph W. Seifert. On February 12, 2025, Mr. Seifert petitioned the Court for Relief from the Rule of Good Standing so that he might seek admission to the bar of the Court. Under D.C.COLO.LAttyR 3(a), an applicant for admission to the bar must be "in good standing in all courts and jurisdictions where the applicant has been admitted." Under D.C.COLO.LAttyR 3(c), Good Standing is defined as "not suspended or disbarred by any court for any reason." The State Bar of Minnesota listed Mr. Seifert's bar status as "Administratively Suspended" for noncompliance with continuing legal education requirements. In a recommendation dated September 12, 2025, the Committee on Conduct advised the Disciplinary Panel that it twice contacted Mr. Seifert to ask that he provide further information in support of his petition, but did not receive a response from him. The Committee on Conduct therefore recommended that Mr. Seifert's petition be denied. The Disciplinary Panel concurs with the Committee on Conduct's recommendation.

Wherefore, it is ORDERED that JOSEPH W. SEIFERT's February 12, 2025 petition is denied and Mr. Seifert is denied relief from the Rule of Good Standing under D.C.COLO.LAttyR 3(d)(1).
