ORDER OF DISBARMENT




On May 30, 2018, the Disciplinary Panel of this Court entered an Order to Show Cause why Respondent, Micah Jared Smith, should not be disbarred from the practice of law in light of Respondent's stipulation to the Colorado Supreme Court that he violated 8.4(b) of the Colorado Rules of Professional Conduct and his concomitant stipulation that disbarment was the appropriate disciplinary sanction for his misconduct. On June 21, 2018, Respondent by letter undated responded to the order to show cause, stating that he could not show cause why he should not be disbarred and "consent[ed] to disbarment from this Court."


It is therefore ORDERED that MICAH JARED SMITH is DISBARRED from the practice of law before the District Court for the District of Colorado.
