ORDER OF REINSTATEMENT TO THE BAR OF THE COURT


Before the Disciplinary Panel is the application of Lee Travis Balman, petitioning the Court under D.C.COLO.LAttyR 11(a)(3) for reinstatement to the bar. On January 27, 2025, the Chair for the Committee on Conduct, Troy R. Rackham, filed with the Court a unanimous recommendation of the Committee that the Disciplinary Panel grant Mr. Balman's petition for reinstatement. Having reviewed the Chair's recommendation letter and other pertinent documentary evidence on file, the Disciplinary Panel concurs with the Committee's recommendation. The Disciplinary Panel agrees with the Committee that Mr. Balman has satisfied the requirements for reinstatement under D.C.COLO.LAttyR 11(a)(3) by offering clear and convincing evidence of his rehabilitation and fitness to practice law.

It is therefore

ORDERED that LEE TRAVIS BALMAN is reinstated to the practice of law before the United States District Court for the District of Colorado pursuant to D.C.COLO.LAttyR 11(a)(3), subject to any extant conditions of reinstatement imposed by the Colorado Supreme Court.
