ORDER OF REINSTATEMENT AND RELIEF FROM THE RULE OF GOOD STANDING

Before the Disciplinary Panel is the application of Philip M. Falco, III seeking relief from the Rule of Good Standing under D.C.COLO.LAttyR 3(d)(3) and reinstatement to the bar of the court under D.C.COLO.LAttyR 11(a)(3). On April 5, 2019, the Chair for the Committee on Conduct, Suneeta Hazra, filed with the court a unanimous recommendation of the Committee that the Disciplinary Panel grant Mr. Falco relief from the Rule of Good Standing and approve his petition for reinstatement to the court's bar. Having reviewed the Chair's letter incorporating the Subcommittee's report to the full Committee and other documentary evidence on file, the Disciplinary Panel concurs with its recommendation.

It is therefore

ORDERED that Philip M. Falco, III is granted relief from the Rule of Good Standing and reinstated to the practice of law before the United States District Court for the District of Colorado.


