ORDER OF REINSTATEMENT TO THE BAR OF THE COURT

Before the Disciplinary Panel is the application of Nirav Mahendra Jamindar seeking reinstatement to the bar of the court under D.C.COLO.LAttyR 11(a)(3). On January 5, 2023, the Chair for the Committee on Conduct, Brooke H. Meyer, filed with the court a unanimous recommendation of the Committee that the Disciplinary Panel grant Mr. Jamindar's petition for reinstatement.
