ORDER OF REINSTATEMENT

Before the Disciplinary Panel is the application of David J. Mahalek seeking reinstatement to the bar of the court under D.C.COLO.LAttyR 11(a)(3). On June 7, 2019, the Chair for the Committee on Conduct, Suneeta Hazra, filed with the court a unanimous recommendation of the Committee that the Disciplinary Panel grant Mr. Mahalek's petition for reinstatement to the court's bar without imposing any conditions under D.C.COLO.LAttyR 11(a)(6). Having reviewed the Chair's letter and other pertinent documentary evidence on file, the Disciplinary Panel concurs with the Committee's recommendation.

It is therefore




