REGISTRATION OF JUDGMENTS FOR ENFORCEMENT IN OTHER DISTRICTS 28 U.S.C. § 1963

To register an out-of-district judgment in the United States District Court, District of Colorado:

 Complete a <u>Clerk's Certification of a Judgment To Be Registered in Another District</u> (Form AO-451) and submit it to the district court that entered the judgment, in accordance with that court's procedures. Contact the district court or visit their website for current fees for completion of the certificate and copies. The form should be returned to you signed by the clerk, with a certified copy of the judgment attached.
Present to our office in person or by mail:

- The signed AO-451 form and the certified copy of the judgment to be registered.
- The filing fee payment for registering a judgment from another district (rj case) pursuant to the current fee schedule. See <u>Schedule of Fees</u>.

To obtain a certified copy of a judgment entered in this Court for registration in another district:

1) Complete a <u>Clerk's Certification of a Judgment To Be Registered in Another District</u> (Form AO-451).

2) Submit the completed AO-451 form to the Clerk's Office for the District of Colorado. You may submit the form in person the Denver courthouse, or you may mail the completed form, together with the fee payment to: Clerk's Office, Alfred A. Arraj United States Courthouse, 901 19th Street, Denver, CO 80294.

3) The fee payment must include payment for each Certificate of Judgment, plus payment for reproduction of any record or paper (per sheet) pursuant to the current Fee Schedule. See <u>Schedule of Fees</u>.

4) Your AO-451 form will be returned to you with a certified copy of the judgment; submit these documents to the district in which you want to register the judgment, and follow that court's procedures for doing so.
