**IMPLEMENTATION OF REVISED
JURY PLAN FOR RANDOM JURY SELECTION**

Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1863 and the Revised Jury Plan for Random Jury Selection (Jury Plan) adopted by the District Court on December 7, 2016 and approved by the 10th Circuit Judicial Council on January 30, 2017,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. The Jury Plan shall become effective on March 1, 2017.
2. The Clerk of the Court is designated to perform all delegable duties specified in the Jury Plan.

These include, but are not limited to, the following duties:

- a. Select names to be placed in the master jury wheel in order to ensure that it holds the minimum number of names required by Section 9 of the Jury Plan;
- b. Randomly draw prospective jurors from the master jury wheel in accordance with Section 10 of the Jury Plan;
- c. Summon petit and grand jurors as necessary, or as ordered by a judicial officer, in accordance with Sections 11 and 12 of this Plan as follows:
 - (1) For grand juries sitting in Denver, on a pro-rata basis from Jury Division One and Four;
 - (2) For petit juries sitting in Denver, from Jury Division One;
 - (3) For juries sitting in Durango, from Jury Division Two;
 - (4) For juries sitting in Grand Junction, from Jury Division Three; and
 - (5) For juries sitting in Colorado Springs, from Jury Division Four.

d. Determine the qualifications, disqualifications, exemptions and excuses of prospective jurors based on the information provided on the juror qualification questionnaire and other competent evidence, in accordance with Sections 16, 17, and 18 of the Jury Plan. Determination of undue hardship excuses in special petit jury panels is reserved to each panel's presiding judicial officer unless specifically delegated to the Clerk of Court for that panel.

3. The Jury Division revisions incorporated in Section 6 of the Jury Plan shall become effective upon the refilling of the Master Jury Wheel and will begin with jurors sitting in July, 2017.
