PUBLIC NOTICE

In accordance with the Jury Selection and Service Act of 1968 (28 U.S.C. § 1861) and pursuant to the authority of the revised jury plan for random jury selection adopted by the United States District Court for the District of Colorado, all litigants “have the right to grand and petit jurors selected at random from a fair cross section of the community.”

Names of prospective jurors for the master jury wheel are randomly selected from the Colorado voter registration records, records of the Colorado licensed drivers and state issued adult identification records.

The United States District Court for the District of Colorado uses a one step process to randomly select names of prospective jurors from the master jury wheel for the purpose of summoning and to determine qualification for petit and grand jury service.

Selection of names are carried out through a properly programmed electronic data processing system for the systematic randomized selection. The systematic randomized process ensures that the mathematical odds of any single names being selected are substantially equal.
