D.C.COLO.LCivR 5.6 **ELECTRONIC CASE FILING**

- Α. **ELECTRONIC FILING:** Pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 5(e), the court will permit papers to be filed, signed, and verified by electronic means. Electronic case filing shall be governed by standards and procedures set forth in a manual entitled "Electronic Case Filing Procedures for the District of Colorado." The current version of that manual shall be available in the clerk's office, and shall be posted on the court's web site.
- Β. **TIME:** Nothing in the Electronic Case Filing Procedures for the District of Colorado alters the rules governing the computation of the deadlines for filing and service of documents that are set forth at Fed. R. Civ. P. 6.
- С. SERVICE: Parties are authorized to make service under Fed. R. Civ. P. 5(b)(2)(D) through the court's transmission facilities.

D.C.COLO.LCrR 49.4 **ELECTRONIC CASE FILING**

Α. ELECTRONIC FILING: Pursuant to Fed. R. Crim. P. 49, the court will permit papers to be filed, signed, and verified by electronic means. Electronic case filing shall be governed by standards and procedures set forth in a manual entitled "Electronic Case Filing Procedures for the District of Colorado." The

current version of that manual shall be available in the clerk's office and shall be posted on the court's web site.

- **B. TIME:** Nothing in the Electronic Case Filing Procedures for the District of Colorado alters the rules governing the computation of deadlines for filing and service of documents that are set forth at Fed. R. Crim. P. 45.
- **C. SERVICE:** Pursuant to Fed. R. Crim. P. 49, parties are authorized to make service through the court's transmission facilities.
