In accord with the Anti-Deficiency Act, 31 U.S.C., §§ 1341 and 1342 and The Guide to Judiciary Policy, Volume 13, Ch.2, § 220.30,

**IT IS ORDERED** that because the functions performed by all employees and judicial officers of this court and the staffs of the judicial officers of this court are necessary and essential to the court's constitutional duty to hear and decide cases according to normal schedules and priorities, all employees shall work full time during any funding lapse.

To the fullest extent practicable during a funding lapse, court activities shall be limited to those functions necessary and essential to the continued resolution of cases. Travel and other expenses shall be limited to those necessary to support the operations of the court.

Unless modified or revoked by the Chief Judge, this order shall remain in effect throughout the current fiscal year.
