COURT OPERATIONS UNDER EXIGENT CIRCUMSTANCES CREATED BY COVID-19 DISTRICT COURT GENERAL ORDER 2020-9

Due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, this General Order modifies certain dates in General Order 2020-6. The justification for this General Order is the same as for General Orders 2020-3, 2020-6, and 2020-8. It is

ORDERED that, through June 19, 2020, only those persons with official court business shall enter the courthouses and U.S. Probation Offices of the United States District Court for the District of Colorado. It is further

ORDERED that all naturalization ceremonies scheduled through June 19, 2020 are POSTPONED and will be rescheduled. It is further

ORDERED that all public and bar-related functions scheduled to take place in any courthouse facility in the District of Colorado through June 19, 2020 are CANCELED.

All other terms of General Order 2020-3 remain in effect through June 19, 2020. Trials are continued up to July 6, 2020, as noted in General Order 2020-8.
