**DISTRICT COURT GENERAL ORDER
2021-8**

WHEREAS, the President signed the Juneteenth National Independence Day Act on the afternoon of June 17, 2021;

WHEREAS, the Juneteenth National Independence Day Act establishes June 19 as a federal holiday to commemorate the end of slavery in the United States;

WHEREAS, under 5 U.S.C. § 6103(b), a legal holiday that falls on a Saturday is observed the preceding Friday;

WHEREAS, June 19, 2021 is a Saturday, making Friday, June 18, 2021 the day on which the holiday is observed;

WHEREAS, the Court, not knowing the timing of the legislation's enactment, has trials and hearings set on the dockets of numerous judges on June 18, 2021; it is hereby

ORDERED that previously set trials and hearings may take place as scheduled on June 18, 2021 and the Clerk's Office will remain open.
