Plaintiff has filed Administrative Tort Claim TRT-NCR-2019-07647 to which Regional Counselor defaulted in its judgment by not being in compliance with the Rules that governs. Regional Counselor had 6 months to Respond. Region did not Request nor obtain AN Extension for Time, therefore it defaulted. Tort claim filed was for Cruel and Unusual Punishment.

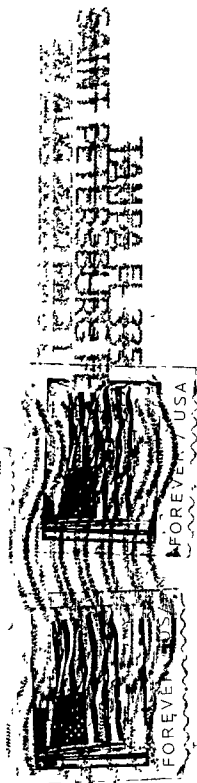
