AMENDMENT TO THE GUIDELINES FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF ATTORNEYS  
PURSUANT TO THE CRIMINAL JUSTICE ACT, 18 U.S.C. § 3006A(b) TO INCREASE  
THE CRIMINAL JUSTICE ACT PANEL FROM 100 LAWYERS TO 150 LAWYERS

Pursuant to the unanimous approval of the judges of this court, it is

ORDERED that the *Guidelines for Appointment of Attorneys Pursuant to the Criminal Justice Act, 18 U.S.C. § 3006 (A)(b)* for the District of Colorado are amended in section I A b to increase the size of the Criminal Justice Act Panel to 150 lawyers. It is

FURTHER ORDERED that upon approval by the Judicial Council of the Tenth Circuit, the amendment to the guidelines will be in effect.
