Upon action of the court, consistent with sections I.A. and I.C.2., of the Electronic Case Filing Procedures for the District of Colorado (Civil and Criminal), this general order of the court is entered to protect the privacy and security of grand jurors, trial jurors, and potential trial jurors.

IT IS ORDERED as follows:


1. Except for good cause shown in a specific case, the name, signature, or personal identifier information of a grand juror, trial juror, or potential trial juror shall not be included in any document filed pursuant to section I.A. in a civil or criminal case.

2. Any document containing the name, signature, or personal identifier information of a grand juror, trial juror, or potential trial juror shall be filed by delivery to the clerk's office, but shall not be scanned or posted to ECF:

a. Any such document shall be maintained by the clerk.

b. Any such document shall be available for public review, inspection, and copying through the office of the clerk.
